From the Principal

Dear Parents

Welcome back to Term 4! As you can see from the dates above, we have been able to organise some events (all with a COVID-19 Safety Plan) for Term 4. The pace of change due to COVID-19 seems to have slowed somewhat. I will continue to use the Skoolbag APP to update you on any urgent changes and this newsletter to keep you informed generally.

COVID-19

COVID-19 is still impacting on us in many ways. Unfortunately, we are unable to distribute any shared food to students. This includes birthday cakes, cupcakes or lolly bags.

The Department of Education regulations also state if students or staff are ill with COVID-19 symptoms, they cannot return to school until they produce a COVID-19 negative test result.

2021 Dates

This week the Department of Education announced a change to Staff Development Days for 2021 and beyond.

Commencing at the start of 2021, the changes include:

- an increase from one to two SDDs at the commencement of Term 1
- a decrease from two to one SDDs at the end of Term 4.

The School Development Days are scheduled for the following dates:

27 and 28 January, students return 29 January 2021.

The two SDDs at the start of Term 1 are mandated and cannot be rescheduled. Principals may continue to vary SDDs that fall at the beginning of Terms 2 and 3, and at the end of Term 4.

There will be no changes to:

- the total number of SDDs remaining at five days
- the length of the school year for staff or students (students will start and finish the school year one day later)
- SDDs occurring at the commencement of Terms 2 and 3.

Great news!!!!!


We have some new items coming to our menu.... From Monday you will be able to order Butter Chicken, this is an 'everyday' item and is also **Gluten free.**
