From the Principal

Welcome back to Term 3.

This term sees us beginning with the continuation of many restrictions in place due to COVID-19. These include:

- Pick up and drop off routines for students will remain the same as last term. Parents are still not allowed onto the school grounds. K-2 students (without siblings in 3-6) may still be picked up early (2.40pm) from the top Rondelay Drive gate.
- There will be no Term Accounts sent home for Term 3 and no excursions have been scheduled.

 Assemblies will continue via video. Parents can access this through the link in the school newsletter or the school website.

- The canteen will continue to operate for lunch orders only, please also see information regarding the canteen in the section below.
- School banking will not be operating until further notice.
- Enhanced cleaning of school facilities will continue, including cleaning throughout the day.
- Students will not be allowed to share food at school. This includes birthday cakes, these will not be allowed onsite until the end of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Some restrictions are beginning to ease or be lifted. These include:

- SRE lessons will recommence. SRE volunteers will be required to sign a COVID-19 declaration before entering the premises.
- PSSA will commence during Term 3.
- Recess orders will be available through the school canteen. Please note all canteen orders must be completed via the Qkr! App, no cash will be accepted.
- School Photos are now allowed. Excelsior school photos have been scheduled for Monday 14th September.
- Community users can now recommence. Students involved in after and before school activities should have been informed about changed procedures, including drop off and pick up areas outside of the school gates.

I will continue to update parents, through the Skoolbag App, as changes occur. I encourage all parents to download this App and register to Excelsior Public School.

Staff Changes

In Term 3 we have welcomed back two staff members.

Ms. Chevalier has returned from 6 months relieving as Deputy Principal at Beresford Road Public School. Ms. Chevalier will be working in the role of Assistant Principal, Instructional Leader. She will also be running our XT program this term.

Mrs. Kelly Barton has return from maternity leave. She will be working 3 days per week in the role of English as an Additional Language or Dialect (EALD) teacher.

School improvements

Over the holidays, we had some new equipment installed.

The hall now has a new projector and outdoor speakers, this will be highly beneficial when we return to normal operation as it will allow the COLA to be used during large assemblies or productions without a loss in sound quality.

We also had new speakers installed into the playgrounds and into all classrooms. This now allows us to make announcements to the whole school, enables music and bells to be heard through the school.

We are currently fine tuning the volume levels. If you are a close neighbour to our school and feel that the PA system volume is too loud, please let us know.

Year 5 Check-In Assessment

As you are aware NAPLAN has been cancelled for 2020, due to COVID-19. Schools have been offered to participate in an online reading and numeracy

assessment for students in Year 5 and 9. Excelsior Public School students will be participating in this assessment.

Grow Your Mind

Excelsior Public School is committed to promoting and teaching strategies for positive mental health and wellbeing. We have started using a program that promotes whole school flourishing called Grow Your Mind. During our first session we explored all the ways we look after our physical health daily. Brushing our teeth, eating fruit and vegetables, drinking water etc. Then we explored how we look after our minds on a daily basis. This was harder to do initially! Children were then asked to point to their toes, their heart, their prefrontal cortex...! And so the journey has begun of brain awareness. Listen out for your child talking about shrinking their Guard Dog, or growing their Wise Owl, their Elephant and their Sifting Sooty.

Grow Your Mind mental health tip #1: To shrink your Guard Dog (aka your amygdala):

- 1. Take 3 anchor breaths
- 2. Try finger breathing

3. Think of one thing or person you are thankful for.
